

MISC Commitment to Net Zero GHG Emissions by 2050

MISC commitment is to achieve net zero greenhouse gases (GHG) emissions by 2050 that is in line with MISC's Vision and Mission.

The commitment is informed by:

- i. MISC business context
- ii. Relevant national policies
- iii. Applicable international frameworks
- iv. Climate science

In line with the above, we will continue to explore business growth opportunities in the low carbon economy and we will take actions to reduce our operational greenhouse gas emissions, through decarbonisation levers, such as:

- i. Energy efficiency
- ii. Carbon capture and storage
- iii. Fleet renewal with zero-emission vessels
- iv. Use of renewable energy

We will explore collaborative efforts with our suppliers and customers to reduce our Scope 3 emissions.

Carbon offset will only be used for the remaining hard-to-abate emissions as recognised and allowed for by relevant international standards.

All employees are required to align all business activities with the approach and targets set by MISC to achieve net zero GHG emissions by 2050.

The commitment is approved by the Board of Directors, and its implementation is overseen by the Executive Leadership Team.
